Correspondence:

PENNDOT sent notification of the township's estimated allocation money for Liquid Fuels. The amount is \$94,587.36

SWN sent notice of Intent for Consumptive use at Bolles South Well Pad.

Roadmaster:

- -Pretty sure we don't have to do a single audit.
- -Filed for \$497,526.06 reimbursement for FEMA.
- -Graded, raked and rolled Booth, Pratt, Johnson, Lake Roy, Ebbs, Bronson and Hunsinger. We still have to file for reimbursement.
- -Cinder Shed is set for delivery 10/11/22.
- -Grader is causing all kinds of trouble. Number 3 injector which we replaced a couple years ago. It just skips badly and we have to stop and reset and maybe it starts again. Leaking out of all wheel gear box, again which they fixed a couple years ago for \$27,000. Front wheel drive does not work most of the time. Replaced sensors twice and still not working. Sometimes it runs at high speed and throws grader sideways and sometimes won't work at all. Parts are getting hard, because Volo quit building graders.

New Business:

Ordinance Notice will be advertised in the paper. This ordinance is to enact tax credits for members of volunteer fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical service companies. The Supervisors will hear public comment and act on the proposed ordinance at the November 1st meeting.

There is a problem with the offices copy machine upper carriage which makes scanning and faxing impossible. The supervisors decided to purchase a new one. Mark made a motion to purchase a new printer. Lee seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Old Business:

Lee asked about the DCED audit. John Nonnemacher from Snyder and Clementi will conduct the audit. Lee asked if a Single Audit has to be done for 2022, will John complete also complete the DCED audit for 2022.

Lee asked about the status of the FEMA Buy Out properties. There was a discussion about mowing the newly acquired properties.

Lee asked about a resolution with the outdated check in the filing cabinet for a holding tank. No decision was made.

The supervisors discussed the contracts with the fire companies.

Lee inquired about the new delivery date for the Cinder Shed.

Lee made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mark seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
