- Put rip rap on Forks Hill Road by Hollenback's
- Trouble on bottom of Johnson Road. Plan on putting more rip rap there. We had stop short of bottom where there is a 24" pipe. That pipe flowed over and tore the ditch out. We plan to put a 36" pipe in and rip rap on to bottom.
- Do we want to keep spraying the rest of the roads: We do have to respray some. Pratt, Lake Roy, Hawk and Gontarski. We have not done Olszewski, Quarry, South Bailey, Haines, Buckley, Salt Springs. Spray trucks are limited availability now.

Mike, the representative from Midland spoke. He explained the process and answered questions.

New Business:

In the Q & A section of the Township News there were questions about if townships were exempt from paying federal and state excise tax on fuel. Mark asked if the township was paying tax.

Lee made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mark seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 7:51 PM.
