The monthly township meeting was called to order by Supervisor Creamer at 7:00pm with Supervisor Phil Depue present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes from July 2, 2024 were reviewed and a motion to approve last month's minutes was made by Supervisor Creamer and seconded by Supervisor DePue.

The financial report was reviewed. Supervisor Creamer made a motion to approve said financial report and was seconded by Supervisor DePue.

Supervisor Depue gave the Roadmaster Report as follows:

-Discussed severity of the storms.

They have been grading roads, mowing and spraying dust control.

On schedule to complete Tar & Chip on all the remaining roads on August 15th and was informed by Vestal Asphalt it will only take 1 day to complete all 5 roads.

The vehicle counter was on Hawk Rd. for a week and 560 vehicles were counted for said week. The counter is now on Hunsinger. Township is using the counter to narrow down which road would be the best choice to Tar & Chip next year if the Township decides to do so.

Supervisor Creamer made a motion to approve the Susquehanna Hazard Mitigation Plan, Resolution 2024-8, which would allow the Township to partake in emergency funds if the County were to receive any. The motion was seconded by Supervisor DePue.

Supervisor Creamer reviewed the correspondences. Township received the Workmen's Comp Audit of \$105,000 and the paper was made available for the public to view.

COMMENTS:

Dale and Lori Webster commented on how nice the roads are so far. The bare patches where you turn from Hawk Rd. onto Booth Rd. was brought up. Supervisor Depue informed the public Vestal Asphalt will fix the bare portions of the road for free.

Supervisor Creamer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:10pm, seconded by Supervisor Depue.
